You will get all news and articles on topic of interest.*

• Notification settings differ from one data base to another. see how to turn on email notifications at Oxford Journals.

New issues notification. Get an email with a list of all articles in a new issue.

Article activity notification. Get and email about new commentaries, new citations, corrections and refutations.

Preprint notification. Get an email about new articles available before and/or after a paper is published in a journal.





- **Search results notification.** Get an email notification when new articles suitable for your search enquiry get published. For instance, choose a subject and you will get notification on new articles on this subject
- **Citation notifications**. Get an email when a chosen article is cited. Available only at several data bases, for example, Taylor & Francis.

Sign in at a platform. Create an account if you still don't have one — it will only take a few minutes.
