
Abstract and Keywords

Levels of economic inequality differ extensively when comparisons are made between nation states, although, worldwide, inequalities remain highest in the poorest countries. Yet now even some of the wealthiest nations have markedly high levels of income inequality. This chapter concentrates on illustrating this unprecedented, contemporary transformation in income inequalities towards greater geographical variation between affluent countries. In particular, new data analysis included here uncovers significant idiosyncrasies in the income distributions of the UK and USA, as compared with other wealthy countries. Increasingly robust evidence suggests that high and rising inequalities in a few affluent nations have far-reaching implications, and income inequality should be recognized as a source of extensive negative externalities. These recent developments underscore the need for the subdiscipline of economic geography to focus far more on understanding patterns and changes in income inequality within prosperous nations. Thus far, geographers have largely neglected the subject and its consequences.

Labeling a refugee migration as a "crisis" is not an inevitable action to large-scale forced migration. It is a choice that is steeped in racial, gender, and colonialist politics. The choice to label a situation a crisis might have underlying it good intentions for highlighting migrants' dire situations, but it can also have negative discursive (and potentially material) consequences. Discursively, labeling a crisis could justify a more defensive stance than a humanitarian approach, leading to greater border enforcement and less willingness to provide protection and assistance to refugees. This chapter outlines some of the negative responses that are typical in US discourse on refugees, and how those responses tend to misinterpret the real nature of refugee crises, using the situation of Central American asylum seekers entering the United States in the mid-2010s as an exemplar.

THE phrase "refugee crisis" frequently gets thrown around, and more often than not we take for granted that we know what it means. But do we? The label "crisis" connotes numerous types of potential threats to safety and stability, and many of these threats have particular gendered consequences that are not immediately obvious. In the context of migration to the United States, where the face of a dangerous migrant is usually a brownskinned man and the face of a dependent migrant is often a brown-skinned woman with children, using the term "refugee crisis" to describe a particular migration flows is not an apolitical act. Rather, it is a way of framing a migration situation in such a way that it garners an emotional reaction, either one of compassion, fear, or even anger. But it often obscures the real nature of the migration, the challenges and possibilities it presents, and while "crisis" can motivate quick action, it does not always facilitate action that is thoughtful and effective.

STATISTICS AND THE ART OF MODEL CONSTRUCTION

INTRODUCTION

Constructing and evaluating behavioral science models is a complex process. Decisions must be made about which variables to include, which variables are related to each other, the functional forms of the relationships, and so on. The last 10 years have seen a substantial extension of the range of statistical tools available for use in the construction process. The progress in tool development has been accompanied by the publication of handbooks that introduce the methods in general terms (Arminger et al., 1995; Tinsley & Brown, 2000a). Each chapter in these handbooks cites a wide range of books and articles on specific analysis topics.

Recent developments are too broad to cover in detail in a single chapter. Instead, this chapter examines current statistical modeling practices from a particular perspective: How can available statistical tools be translated into practices that improve the quality of behavioral science models?

Framing the Problem

For the purposes of this chapter, a high-quality model is defined as a model that is grounded in reliable knowledge. Reliable knowledge is produced when a scientific community reaches a consensus interpretation (Ziman, 1978) developed




In the current economic environment, social workers are increasingly being required to support households that suffer from severe debt burdens. However, previous research has questioned if social workers are sufficiently prepared to meet this emerging form of financial exclusion, especially from a gender perspective. Thus, there is a risk that interventions for indebted households will overlook gender-specific, inequality-generating patterns in the acquisition and management of debts. With this in mind, the aim of this article is to provide an overview of the existing literature related to gender and household debt, in order to enable a development towards gender-aware social work interventions that equally support women and men in creating financially stable lives. The results show that gender dynamics affect how households acquire and manage their debt. These dynamics result in different forms and levels of debt for women and men, unequally divided spheres of responsibility for managing the acquired debt burden and differences in their willingness to seek debt advice. Unequal power relations between men and women and gender-stereotypic expectations are found to be key factors for explaining these results. The results are discussed in relation to practical implications for social policy and social work practice.


