When I finished my bachelor's degree in psychology I needed to find work. Although I was interested in media, I wasn't really qualified to do anything. Nevertheless, I stumbled into a job in audience research at Children's Television Workshop. According to news reporting originating in Princeton, New Jersey, by NewsRx journalists, research stated, "Pegfilgrastim is available as a prefilled syringe (PFS) and an on-body injector (OBI). Whether the administration method of pegfilgrastim affects the effectiveness and health care resources has not been evaluated in the setting of routine care."


The news reporters obtained a quote from the research from Sandoz Inc., "To compare real-world clinical and economic outcomes between PFS and OBI methods of administration. This was a retrospective observational study in patients diagnosed with breast cancer or non-Hodgkin lymphoma who received myelosuppressive chemotherapy and prophylactic use of pegfilgrastim via PFS or OBI between January 1, 2017, and May 31, 2018, according to MarketScan research databases. A propensity score was used to match the PFS cohort 1:1 to the OBI cohort. Outcomes were compared among the matched cohorts using a generalized linear model and generalized estimating equations with log-link function. 3,152 patients were identified. After matching, the final sample included 2,170 patients, representing 1,085 in each cohort. The incidence of febrile neutropenia (FN) in the first chemotherapy cycle was 1.01% for OBI (95% CI = 0.56-1.82) vs 1.48% for PFS (95% CI=0.91-2.39; P=0.336). In all chemotherapy cycles (total cycles =7,467), the FN incidence was 0.91% for OBI (95%) CI = 0.64-1.30) vs 1.22% for PFS (95% CI =0.90-1.64; P=0.214). There was no statistically significant difference in adjusted per-member per-month all-cause total cost health care resource utilization (HCRU) for hospitalizations, emergency department visits, and pharmacy claims. In a matched cohort of patients representing real-world utilization, there was no statistically or clinically meaningful difference in FN incidence between OBI and PFS methods of pegfilgrastim administration. There was no difference in total HCDII or total costs."



Adam Smith's formal legacy to posterity consisted of meticulously revised editions of his two published works, and; long-standing plans for treatises on Jurisprudence, Rhetoric, and the Fine Arts were abandoned on the grounds that there was no time to complete them. Adam Smith is often seen as an unrewarding subject for biography. Dugald Stewart, his first and greatest biographer, saw him as a quiet, unassuming man who led a relatively uneventful life and preferred the peace and quiet of his native Kirkcaldy and the company of old friends to the bustle of Glasgow, Edinburgh, or London. We know him now as a notoriously poor correspondent who valued his privacy, who deplored the current fashion for biographical tittle-tattle and who, at the end of his life, made an archival bonfire of most of his private papers and unfinished texts in an attempt to preserve his biographical privacy. For Smith was a philosopher who believed that a writer should be remembered for his works rather than his life, and for works that were finished, published and polished rather than for those which were incomplete and had yet to reach the public. It was for this reason that he reluctantly abandoned ambitious plans for new treatises on government, philosophy and the fine arts and spent his last years polishing and perfecting the texts of his two great published masterpieces, the Theory of Moral Sentiments and The Wealth of Nations. 



1. Information, in any form, on which computer programs operate. The distinction between program (instructions) and data is a fundamental one in computing (see VON NEUMANN MACHINE). It is in this fundamental sense that the word is used in terms such as data, data break, data bus, data cartridge, data communications, data compression, data name, data protection, data subject, and data type.

2. In a more limited sense, data is distinguished from other contrasting forms of information on which computers operate, such as text, graphics, speech, and image. The distinguishing characteristic is that it is organized in a structured, repetitive, and often compressed way. Typically the structure takes the form of sets of fields, where the field names are omitted (this omission being a main means of achieving compression). The 'meaning' of such data is not apparent to anyone who does not know what each field signifies (for example, only a very limited meaning can be attached to '1234' unless you know that it occupies the 'employee number' field). That characteristic gives rise to the popular fallacy that 'data is meaningless'.

Terms such as database, data dictionary, data hierarchy, data independence, data model, data preparation, and data processing normally carry this second sense—though not invariably; the context should determine which sense is intended.






