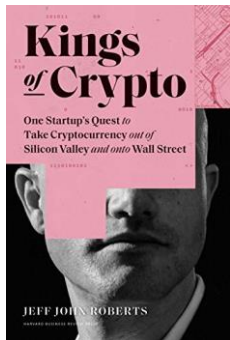
We are happy to announce that we will be developing our e-book collection through **demand-driven acquisition** or **DDA**.

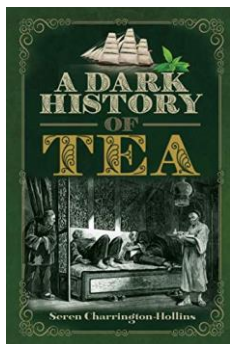
Kings of Crypto: One Startup's Quest to Take Cryptocurrency Out of Silicon Valley and Onto Wall Street

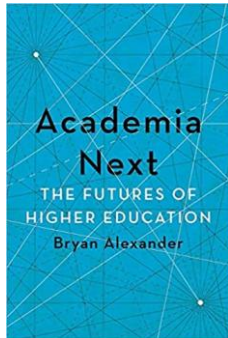
A Dark History of Tea

On May 27–28, the deputy director of the Library **Vladimir Pislyakov** participated in organizing the professional development programme “Research Efficiency and Publication Activities of Educational and Scientific Institutions” based at Herzen University in Saint-Petersburg.

As part of the programme, he delivered three lectures on bibliometrics. The topics of these lectures covered the history and the development of bibliometric indicators, challenges in the co-authorship of research papers and in sharing the resulting notoriety, and the impact of self-citing in scientific literature.
